Notary Consumer Disclosure Requirement (SB 1050)

Effective **January 1, 2015**, pursuant to Senate Bill 1050, the Lassen County Recorder's Office will require the Notary Consumer Disclosure for acknowledgments taken in California. This bill requires a legible notice at the <u>top</u> of the certificate of acknowledgment in an <u>enclosed box</u>, stating that the acknowledgment, proof of execution, or jurat verifies only the identity of the individual who signed the document to which the acknowledgment, proof of execution, or jurat state, proof of execution, or jurat state, proof of execution, or jurat is attached, and not the truthfulness, accuracy, or validity of the document, as specified below:

A notary public or other officer completing this certificate verifies only the identity of the individual who signed the document to which this certificate is attached, and not the truthfulness, accuracy, or validity of that document.

Documents where the person appeared before a notary or other officer on or after **January 1, 2015** must have this disclosure <u>or the document will be rejected.</u> Documents acknowledged <u>before</u> January 1, 2015 will be accepted for recording and must meet current applicable statute.

This requirement has been made in accordance with the legislative amendment to Sections 1189 and 1195 of the Civil Code, and to amend Section 8202 of the Government Code, relating to notaries public.
