In accordance with the provision of Section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code, I am submitting herewith the 1949 annual crop report for the County of Lassen.

The prices quoted in this, our sixth crop report, are gross receipts of harvested crops as received by the farmers and ranchers. The acreage of field crops remains about the same with production in a few instances less than last year. The production and value of potatoes is almost double that of the previous year.

This report shows an overall total of 19,795,049.80 which is about three million dollars less than last year. Also included in this report are grand totals from previous reports.

Our 1949 crop report was made possible through the assistance of ranchers, growers and various agencies, and to them we express our sincere appreciation.
