

Section 65.5 of the California Agricultural Code requires that the Agricultural Commissioner compile a report covering conditions, acreage, production, and value of the Agricultural products of his county.

This tenth annual report is the gross prices received by the farmers of this county for their commodities. The figures shown herein are based on the average gross return to the farmer.

The 1953 income decreased approximately \$3,584,152.00. This decrease was due mostly to the drop in production of lumber. There was a big decrease in the price of cattle, but the total value was more than in 1952, which was the result of more cattle held over and sold in 1953.
