NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 17924 OF THE BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS CODE

Unless a notice of the dissolution of the partnership has been published pursuant to Section 15035.5 of the Corporations Code, this statement of withdrawal from partnership operating under a fictitious business name must be published in newspaper once a week for four successive weeks and an affidavit of publication be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the principal place of business is located.
