NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with the provisions of the California Elections Code, that the **Statewide Direct Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026**. Offices for which candidates may file are as follows: Voter-Nominated Offices (State): Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Controller, Treasurer, Attorney General, Insurance Commissioner, Superintendent of Public Instruction, Member of the State Board of Equalization 1st District, Representative to the Congress of the United States 1st District, Members of the Assembly 1st District. Nonpartisan Offices (Lassen County): Judge of the Superior Court Dept.1, Assessor, Auditor-Controller, Clerk-Recorder, Treasurer-Tax Collector, Superintendent of Schools, Supervisor 3rd District, Supervisor 5th District, and two (2) City Council members*. * City Council candidates file at the City of Susanville, office of the City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in accordance with the provisions of the California Elections Code the **Special Primary Election to fill the vacancy for U.S. Representative Congressional District 1**, will be consolidated with the regularly scheduled Statewide Direct Primary Election to be held on **Tuesday, June 2, 2026**.

QUALIFICATIONS for office: California Elections Code requires all candidates for public office in California to be registered voters and otherwise qualified to vote for the office they are seeking at the time their nomination papers are issued; beyond these general qualifications, some offices require more specific qualifications, and proof that candidates meet these qualifications. Additional qualifications and filing fee amounts can be obtained from the County Clerk's office.

Candidates may obtain Nomination Papers and file their official Declaration of Candidacy from Monday, February 9, 2026, through Friday, March 6, 2026, at the office of the County Clerk located behind the Historic Courthouse at 220 South Lassen Street, Suite 5, Susanville, CA 96130 during regular business hours from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. If the Incumbent does not file, the filing period will be extended through the close of business on Wednesday, March 11, 2026, for any eligible person, other than the incumbent.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that all Lassen County voters will be mailed an official ballot and postage paid return identification envelope for return of the voted ballot beginning on May 4, 2026. Ballots can be mailed, dropped in an Official Ballot Drop Box, delivered to the County Clerk-Elections office, or a polling location by 8 PM on election day, **Tuesday, June 2, 2026**.

Polling locations will be available on **Election Day Tuesday, June 2, 2026 from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM**. The Lassen County Clerk-Election's office will also be open **Saturday, May 30, 2026 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM**.
